RESOLUTION NUMBER 2854--DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON AUGUST 30, 2016

Ms. Jiménez stated the city's primary election had been held on August 30, 2016, which was for three council members and the mayor's seat. The unofficial election results had been received from the Yavapai County Election's Department, and once the results were canvassed by the council they would become the official final election results. Three candidates received a majority of votes cast for the office of council members and were elected outright during the primary election. They would assume office after the general election, as per state law. For the office of mayor, the two candidates who received the highest number of votes, Tim Elinski and Holly Grigaitis, would be placed on the general election ballot for a run-off election.

Mr. Horton stated all five candidates that were on the ballot received enough votes to be elected at the primary, but it was just the three top vote getters, under the statute, that have the seats.

Council Member Pratt moved to approve Resolution Number 2854, declaring and adopting the results of the primary election held on August 30, 2016.

Vice Mayor Pfeifer questioned if we had to name who the three are in the motion.

Ms. Jimenez stated no, but she would state their names for the record: Ruben Jauregui, Deb Althouse, and Tosca Henry.

Council Member Allen seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Vice Mayor Pfeifer request the City Clerk read Resolution Number 2854 by title only.
